Mission Statement

The mission of the Westside Free Medical Clinic is to serve persons unable to obtain basic family practice health care. A small pharmacy assists with prescriptions for patients of the clinic.

The clinic is an equal opportunity agency and does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, nationality, origin, religion, gender, sexual orientation, age, disability or residency.

Services

Although our guidelines are flexible, in order to continue receiving services patients are encouraged to be resourceful within their means.

Misuse of Services

Misuse of clinic resources or failure to follow rules will be grounds for the termination of any services provided by the Westside Free Medical Clinic.

Prescription Policy

We fill only those prescriptions written by the physicians at the Westside Free Medical Clinic.

Due to an increase in patients and prescription demands, all patients are encouraged to fill their own prescriptions whenever they have an alternative to the Westside Free Medical Clinic. We can fill a maximum of four (4) prescriptions per patient every ten to twelve (10-12) weeks.

NOTICE: There are no controlled substances located in pharmacy.

Attendance Policy

Patients are limited to one (1) clinic visit when scheduled. Prescriptions are filled per patient every ten to twelve (10-12) weeks.

Bad Weather

Listen to the radio and T.V. news for changes in clinic hours or appointments due to hazardous weather.

Please be mindful and courteous to the volunteer staff. There would not be a clinic without them.

Prevention
