Dear Searcher,

How is your 4th Day going? Hopefully it is going great, and you have been recognizing the presence of God in ways that you have never noticed before!

The Search Staff is excited to begin preparations for **Search #155 (December 13-15, 2024)**. We are looking for those former Searchers who are interested in serving on one of the Search Teams. Here are some of the expectations of those who are on Search Team:

- 1) You must maintain a lifestyle consistent with that of a young person truly seeking Christ in your life.
- 2) Your actions and behavior must reflect what it means to be a Christian.
- 3) You must be willing to commit to the Search Covenant, which states:

"As a Christian and as a member of the Search Team of the Diocese of Little Rock, I understand that I am accepting God's call to be of service to others and that my behavior should reflect what it means to be a Christian. This would include respecting others as well as myself while also remembering that I am a role model to my peers. I will be careful in the words that I use, the judgments that I make and will not spread rumors about others. I will act out my sexuality in an appropriate manner; keep private things told to me in confidence and abstain from the illegal use of drugs and alcohol."

If you have these values and have been living them, we hope that you will consider serving God and your peers on the Search Team. Those who are on Search Team are dedicated to being of service to all who participate in Search. Planning and hosting a Search requires lots of time, effort, and prayer. We need people who are friendly, mature, and seeking God. We need young people who will be servants - not seeking a reward - only seeking to be of service to God and others. Most of all, we need people who love God and want to share that love with others. If this describes you, we hope you will apply for Search Team. The following is a description of the responsibilities for each team:

<u>**Outside Team</u>** - Our mission is to influence Searchers with the power of God. We influence the Searchers through prayer, skits, and Mass. We are physically present to Searchers only during welcoming, games/icebreakers, skits, meals, and Mass, and leading the group to each building. We are not physically present during talks or discussions.</u>

Inside Team – We are responsible for leading, directing, and managing the tables during the weekend. We also help to develop a bond, especially among those at the table. We also prepare a talk on an assigned topic using Catholic teaching and personal experiences.

To be a part of either Search Team, you **must commit** to these meeting dates (in Little Rock):

Please note that we require **<u>TWO</u>** references for your application to be complete. Additionally, one of the questions we ask your references is if you have explained what SEARCH is... be sure that your references are fully aware of what you are asking them. Finally, adults are busy, so be sure to check back with your references to ensure that they have completed and returned their references to our office. Please don't forget to attach a photo to your application.

Let us keep one another in prayer as we continue our Fourth Day. Remember that Christ is counting on you!
